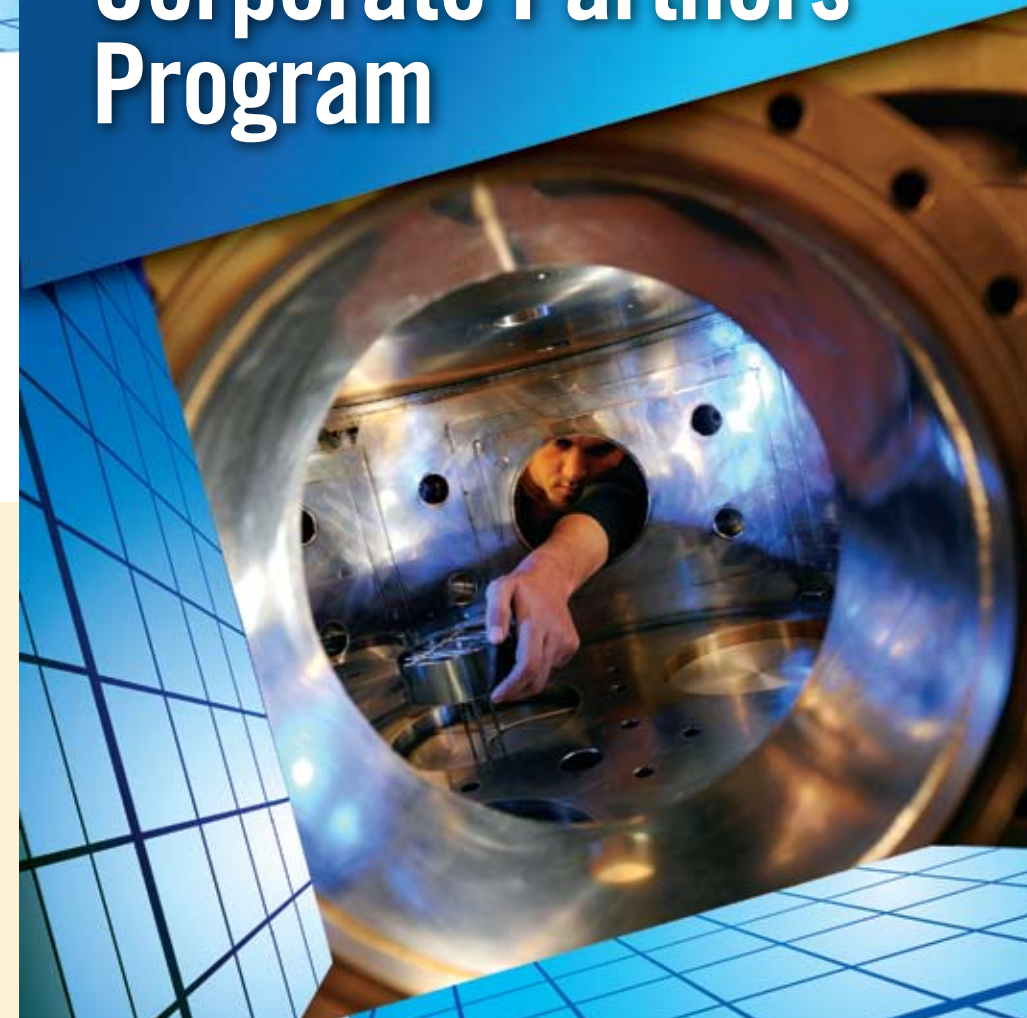
UCR graduate students and employees of Induct SARL with an autonomous vehicle

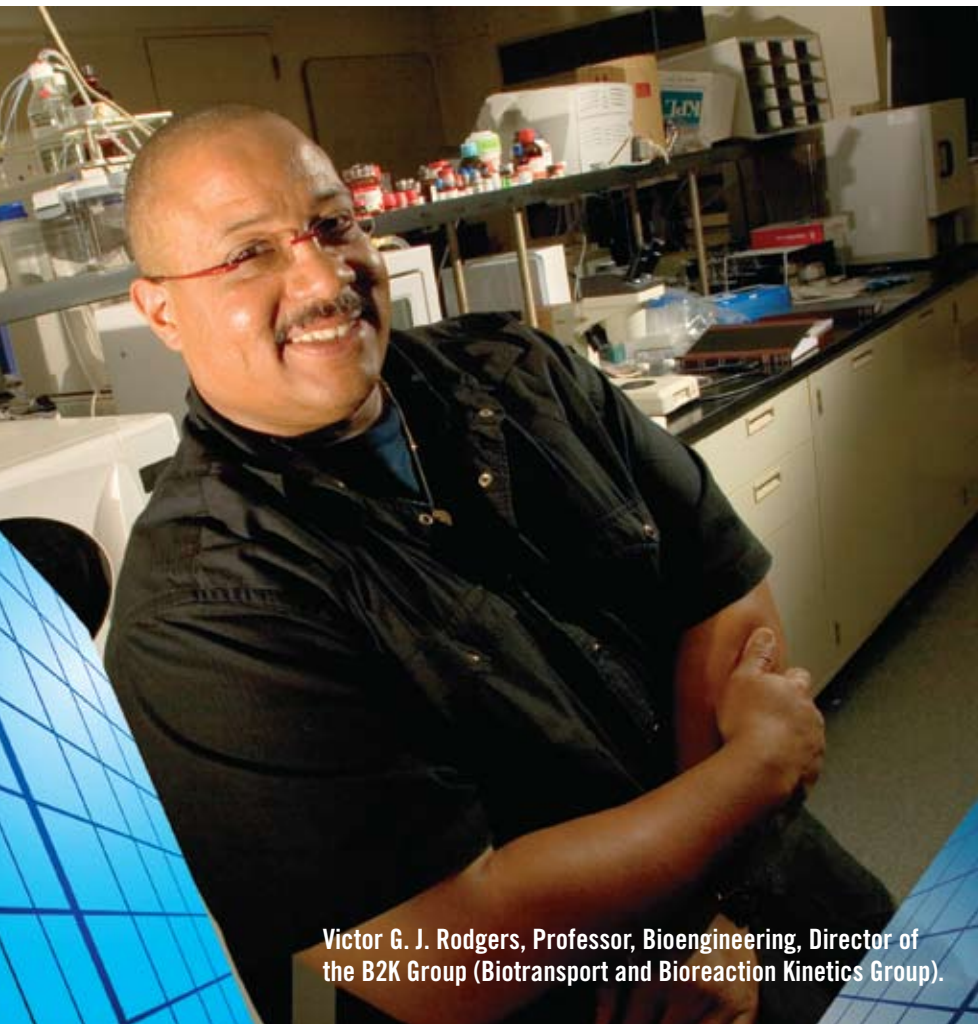

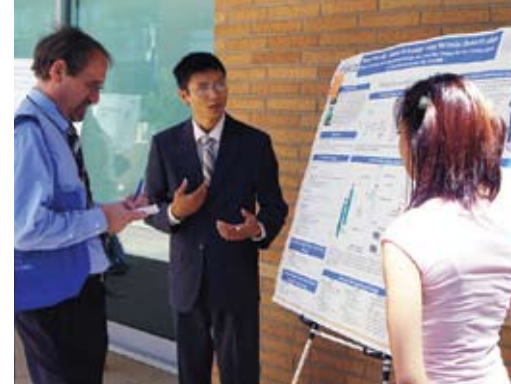

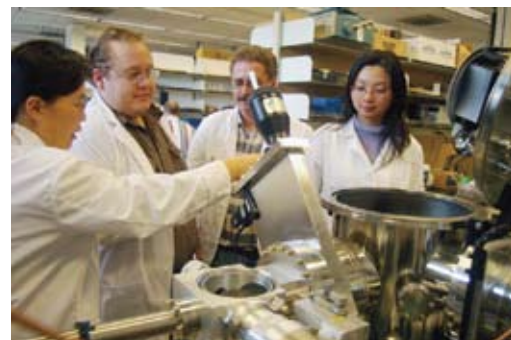
